ARRL Field Day 2023

Field Day 2023: As many of you may know, this year TARA is teaming up with AARA (Albany) to participate in Field Day from the Albany club's location up at the beautiful Thatcher Park in the Helderbergs. The 2023 ARRL Field Day will take place on Saturday June 24th and Sunday June 25th and will take place from 2 PM Saturday until 5 PM Sunday.

What is Field Day???

Field Day is ham radio's open house. Every June, more than 40,000 hams throughout North America set up temporary transmitting stations in public places to demonstrate ham radio's science, skill and service to our communities and our nation. It combines public service, emergency preparedness, community outreach, and technical skills all in a single event. Field Day has been an annual event since 1933, and remains the most popular event in ham radio.



What is the objective of Field Day???

The objective of Field Day is to contact as many stations as possible on the 160-, 80-, 40-, 20-,15- and 10-Meter HF bands, as well as all bands 50 MHz and above, and to learn to operate in abnormal situations in less than optimal conditions.

Who can participate???

Field Day is open to all amateurs in the areas covered by the ARRL/RAC Field Organizations and countries within IARU Region 2. DX stations residing in other regions may be contacted for credit, but are not eligible to submit entries. Each claimed contact must include contemporaneous direct initiation by the operator on both sides of the contact. Initiation of a contact may be either locally or by remote.
